The Center for Learning Outcomes Assessment (CLOA), located at Indian State University in Terre Haute, IN, coordinates and the administration of the University Learning Outcomes Assessment (UniLOA) and maintenance of its National Database.

The UniLOA is a 70-item survey with a set of specialized demographics questions that allows for a better understanding of the ways in and the degree to which college students grow, learn, and develop (GLD) over their collegiate experience. Findings of the UniLOA can assist faculty and administrators in the development of intentional and targeted supports, services, interventions, and programs designed to facilitate higher levels of GLD.

You can be sure that the results of the UniLOA will provide you accurate data concerning your students and their collegiate experience. Ongoing studies indicate the UniLOA has a high degree of validity and internal as well as external reliability.
